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Program Description

The Connect Program – Soliya's flagship Virtual Exchange initiative – is a unique cross-cultural education and exchange program that enables college students from around the world to collaboratively explore the relationships between their societies with the aim of improving intercultural awareness and understanding.

Each semester, participants in the Connect Program will congregate into groups consisting of approximately ten students each. Participants are drawn from institutions in North America, Europe, the Middle East & North Africa, and Asia.

Each group will meet for real-time discussions once via а week for two hours an online. videoconferencing platform. To join the group meetings, participants need simply to turn on their webcam and headset and log on to their group's meeting room at their weekly meeting time. Participants are also able to communicate with their fellow students when they are offline on Soliya's Exchange Portal.



Each participant has access to Soliya's Exchange Portal where you can continue discussions or post messages to other users. You can also engage with the broader Soliya community via the Exchange Portal streams, where you can connect with our diverse network of thousands of young people from around the world. Participants who successfully complete the Connect Program will be invited to continue their journey through Soliya's Continued Engagement activities.

Group Project

You and your fellow group members will work together on creating a social media awareness campaign, and an infographic that will accompany the campaign. Each group will have a focal theme: environment or technology, and will be supported by one or two expert facilitators. You and your fellow group members will have to decide on the scope, message, and content of the campaign. Then, each group's final campaign will be shared on Soliya's primary social media channels, and the Connect Program community members will be invited to vote for their favorite campaigns.

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Collaborate Themes

To help you begin thinking about and explore the collaboration themes, here are some recommendations for sub-topics you can explore with your group, within the given theme. You and your group members will be able to explore the different angles you think are important, and you will work together to identify a sub-topic that will be the focus of your group's awareness campaign. The Connect Program will run from April 3rd to May 5th

- Prior to to the start of the Connect Program, you will participate in a brief online orientation, and complete some introductory activities.
- During the program, you will spend 2 hours per week meeting with your Connect Program group in your online rooms.
- You will be an active contributor to your group's project, and collaborate with your group members to create an awareness campaign.
- You write a reflection paper at the end of the program.
- You will complete a program evaluation at the end of the program.

Note: to obtain the Certificate of Participation, you will need to attend a minimum of 75% of your sessions and complete the program evaluation.

What You Gain

- An opportunity to engage in a collaborative exploration of the critical current issues that affect the global community and are most important to you.
- A chance to meet your peers from around the world, share your opinions, and hear their ideas about critical issues and build strong contacts with future leaders.
- The opportunity to gain and / or improve upon key 21st century skills such as leadership, analytical thinking, engaging across differences constructively, and collaborative problem-solving.
- The Connect Program Certificate of Participation, attesting to the skills and experiences gained through your participation, if you successfully complete all the program requirements
